Annually, the Woman's Wednesday Club (WWC) awards thousands of dollars in scholarships to students demonstrating strong potential as future community leaders.

ELIGIBILITY FOR WWC SCHOLARSHIPS

Applicants must be a:

1. Female resident of Hood County
2. College sophomore, junior or senior:
 - a. Full-time at a four-year college or university
 - b. Have at least a 2.5 grade point average
3. Full or part-time student returning to college after a pause
4. Full-time or part-time student at Weatherford College
5. Full-time student pursuing a Graduate degree

APPLICATION GUIDELINES

Each Applicant must:

- A. Meet the above eligibility criteria
- B. Submit a complete Scholarship Application Packet, consisting of:
 1. A Scholarship Date Form.
 2. A personal statement of the applicant's goals related to the applicant's future career and the applicant's future commitment to public/community service.
 3. A resume' including college accomplishments and service.to the community.
 4. A college/university transcript.
- C. Scholarship Application Packet components 1-3 must be submitted together.

The transcript (4) may be submitted separately.
- D. By submitting a Scholarship Application Packet, scholarship winners consent to having their names, photographs, name of college, and college major published in the WWC Newsletter and published in conjunction with the WWC Scholarship Fundraiser.

NOTE: The Scholarship Committee will not consider incomplete applications.

- **Scholarship Award Notifications will be mailed to recipients the week of November 23, 2026**
- The Scholarship Committee will announce Scholarship Recipients at our **WWC December meeting**
- **WWC will mail scholarship checks to the Financial Aid Office of winning applicant's college/university in January of 2027**
- **If the winning applicant changes college/university for the spring semester, she must notify Scholarship Chair, Sherry Hall - 469.371.9933 sherry@hallofangels.com**

3. Disbursement & Enrollment Changes

Scholarship funds will be sent directly to the recipient's college or university for the spring semester. Recipients who transfer or change institutions for the spring term must promptly notify the Scholarship Chair.
